

## Support for 1<sup>st</sup> Priority

1. Material published in the Times on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2010 with 226 signatures.
2. An open letter to the BMA leadership with 100 signatures, urging a change of policy from “critical engagement” to outright opposition. As a result of this and other pressures the BMA is now holding a Special Representative Meeting on 15<sup>th</sup> March. NHSCA members have been sending in resolutions via their BMA divisions.
3. Material published in the Times on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2011, to coincide with the publication of the Bill, carrying over 300 signatures and delivered to Lansley with 402 signatures.

4. Members have been approaching their MPs and writing to their local papers as well as the national press.
